## Wellock, Harkness Hold NCAA Marks

Two Ashland University football players hold NCAA Division II football records.

Austin Wellock owns the NCAA Division II single-game record for field goals. He booted six three-pointers in a 25-20 victory at Wayne State in 2002. The only other NCAA Division II kicker to have six field goals in a game is Steve Huff of Central Missouri State in 1985.

Former AU wide receiver Chris Harkness holds the NCAA Division II single-season mark for yards-per-catch (minimum 40 catches). In 1987, Harkness averaged 27.7 ypc. He caught 41 passes that record-breaking season.

Several other AU players and teams own NCAA gridiron records.

- Dave Biondo was the NCAA Division II leader in pass efficiency in 1987.
- In 1956 Marion "Shine" Zody led the nation in punting at 43.3 ypp.
- Ashland led the nation in total defense in 1991 (195.5 ypg.) and 1992 (211.5 ypg.). Those same years the Eagles had the best rush defense in all of NCAA Division II ( 1992 – 64.4 ypg., 1991 – 86.9 ypg.)
- The 1972 AU defense led the country in scoring defense (5.6 ypg.).
- In 1948 the Eagles were the best in the nation in pass defense (10.1 ypg.).
