## You Could Be Eligible for \$5,000 in Scholarships!

All high school students in the Class of 2024 and beyond who are enrolled in the College Credit Plus program at AU and who matriculate directly from high school into a bachelor's program will receive a \$1,000 scholarship (\$500 to be awarded in the fall semester and \$500 in the spring semester). This scholarship is renewable each year, for up to four years or \$4,000 and is stackable upon other scholarships and aid.

As a student in the CCP Business Academy, you can earn additional scholarship money by completing AU business courses and enrolling directly into the College of Business and Economics after high school:

- Complete 12 credit hours from the approved courses and matriculate directly into the AU College of Business and Economics:
  - Receive a one-time \$500 scholarship
- Complete 24 credit hours and matriculate directly into the AU College of Business and Economics:
  - Receive a one-time \$1,000 scholarship

Combined with the CCP scholarship, you could earn up to \$5,000 toward your education at Ashland University!

## The Bachelor of Science in business administration degree is comprised of the following types of courses:

- Institutional core courses (these are taken by ALL AU students, AKA "core" or "gen ed" courses)
- Core business courses (such as those in the Academy Program: MGT 240, ACCT 201, MKT 233, etc.)
- Courses in your specific major or program. (See list of COBE majors above.)
- Depending on your major, you may also be required to choose electives.
  - o BUS 151 can count as one of those electives.
  - o ENTP 245 is part of the entrepreneurship major and may also count as an elective.
  - o SMG 161 is part of the sport management major and may also count as an elective.
  - o BUS 151, SMG 161, and ENTP 245 are not part of the core business courses, but you may want to explore them while participating in the CCP Business Academy.
