

2022-2023 DEPENDENT VERIFICATION WORKSHEET

INSTRUCTIONS

- **Documentation:** Complete this verification worksheet and submit along with the documentation requested in Section 3. The worksheet must be signed. Follow the instructions for Tax and Earnings Information very carefully.
- **Deadline:** Documentation must be completed, signed, and submitted within **three weeks** of receipt of this notice.
- **Consequences for Failure to Submit Documentation:** Federal need-based grants, loans, and work study may be canceled entirely if Verification is not complete. You are responsible for any interest that accrues on your student account due to a delay in submitting documentation.
- **Notification of Offer Changes:** If there are differences between your FAFSA information and the information collected through Verification, the Financial Aid Office will electronically correct your FAFSA and notify you of any necessary adjustments to your financial aid offer letter. You will also receive a corrected Student Aid Report from the government.
