

Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loans are packaged per federal regulations and graduate loan borrowing limits. Physician Assistant students may be eligible to borrow up to \$10,250 per semester up to a maximum \$138,500 overall between undergraduate and graduate loan borrowing. Graduate students can also apply for a Federal Grad PLUS Loan or a Private Loan if additional loan borrowing is needed to cover program costs.

The Financial Aid Office will begin packaging aid and generating offer letters for Physician Assistant students in April each year for students who submit a FAFSA and meet eligibility requirements. This provides plenty of time to apply for additional loans as needed.

STEPS TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

- 1** Must be accepted for admission into the Physician Assistant program.
- 2** File the **2022-23 FAFSA** at studentaid.gov/fafsa and include Ashland University's Title IV school code (003012).
- 3** First-time Federal Direct Loan borrowers must complete a Master Promissory Note and Loan Entrance Counseling. *All loan borrowers are encouraged to complete the Annual Student Loan Acknowledgement as well.* Complete these requirements at studentaid.gov.

The Financial Aid Office will begin packaging aid and generating offer letters for Physician Assistant students in March each year. An email will be sent to the student when their offer letter is finalized and viewable on their Self-Service Financial Aid Portal.
