## Your Packing List

## What not to bring:

- Air conditioners
- Alcohol
- Any elements w/ an open heating element
- Candles, incense, and open flames
- Cheater plugs or extension cords
- Coffee pots w/ hot plates
- Space heaters
- Lava or halogen lamps
- Lofts
- Electric potpourri pots
- Excessive clothing
- Hot plates
- Oil popcorn poppers
- Pets
- Scented oil burners
- Slow cookers/crockpots
- Smoke, fog, or other vapor producing machine
- Stolen signs
- Toaster ovens/toasters
