\*Students who take a human biology course (BIOL 1710) at NCSC will satisfy both the AU Natural Science core requirement and the Social Work B.S. major requirement. Those who don't will need to take BIO 100 at AU as part of the SOCWK major. If a non-human biology course from this agreement is selected at NCSC, it will meet the core requirement, but not the Social Work requirement.

\*\*GEOL 1010 Physical Geology will count toward a Natural Science Core requirement IF taken prior to becoming an AU student. No AU course equivalent. May not be taken and transferred for credit by those with junior status or above.

The Associate of Arts: Social Work requires the completion of 61-64 credit hours. This agreement assumes that students have taken the minimum number of courses for each degree and any additional courses suggested by Ashland University, and will complete a min. of 37 hrs (half of the Social Work major) at Ashland University.

The Associate of Arts: Social Work Focus assumes that AU's composition, communication, CCI, math/logic, historical reasoning, natural sciences, humanities, and social sciences requirements have been fulfilled, and that one-half of the aesthetics requirements have been fulfilled. If a student takes one Spanish course and one English course (ENGL 2050/2070), along with PHIL 1110 at NCSC, they will have fulfilled the CCI requirement and the Humanities requirements.
