What is Credit for Prior Learning?

- Documented learning and knowledge gained through experience
- Learning gained outside of a traditional educational institutional environment
- Academic credit alternatives, such as exams, military training, portfolios
- •Unique approaches for meeting program, major and general education requirements
- Publicly verifiable learning outcomes



PLA Boosts Completion and Saves Money

According to CAEL, adults earning credit for prior learning have higher degree completion rates than those without.

49% with credit for prior learning

27% without credit for prior learning

Tuition Savings \$1,067-1,652 per 3 credits Portfolio \$175






Military Credit
