## How to Search for a Roommate

Step 1: Login to housing.ashland.edu using your University username and password.

## Step 2: Complete your housing application.

• If you have not yet completed your housing application, you will need to do so before searching for a roommate.

## Step 3: Create a roommate profile.

- Navigate to "My roommate profile" which can be found under the "Housing" tab.
- Check the "Turn on my profile" box in order to make your profile viewable by other applicants.
- Enter the required information.
  - You can specify who can view the information you enter into the housing application fields. Your options are to share with "All applicants", "My contacts", and/or "Private".
    - "All applicants" means your information will be viewable for anyone who is searching for a potential roommate.
    - "My contacts" means that your information will only be viewable to other applicants once you have accepted a contact request from them.
    - "Private" means that your information will not be viewable to anyone.
  - Any information that you provide at the bottom of your profile on how to contact you will only be viewable to your contacts.
- Click the "Save" button.

  - Other applicants will appear on your screen based on the profile field(s) you selected. From here, you have the option to select "Add to roommate group", "Send contact request", and/or "Block" under the applicants listed.
