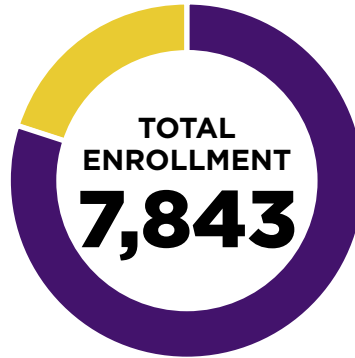

Fall to Fall Retention Rate **72%**



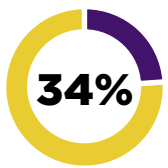
