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What is Credit for Prior Learning?

- Documented learning and knowledge gained through experience
- Learning gained outside of a traditional educational institutional environment
- Academic credit alternatives, such as exams, military training, portfolios
- Unique approaches for meeting program, major and general education requirements
- Publicly verifiable learning outcomes

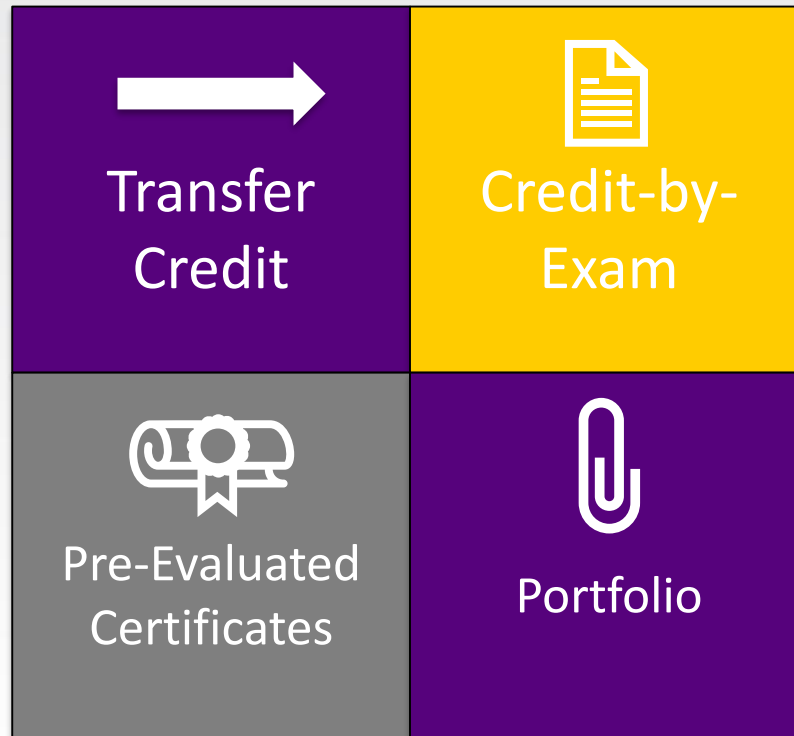

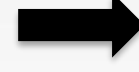

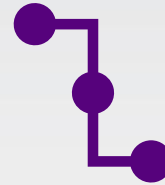
