

**Addendum  
to the  
Master Articulation Agreement  
by and between  
Ashland University and Lorain County Community College**

This Addendum to the Master Articulation Agreement (“Addendum”) is entered into by Ashland University (“University”) and Lorain County Community College (“College”), collectively referred to as the “Parties.”

**WHEREAS**, University and College entered into a Master Articulation Agreement effective May 16, 2025 (“Agreement”);

**WHEREAS**, the Parties wish to supplement the Agreement to allow for students of the College to be eligible for articulated course credits at University; and

**WHEREAS**, the terms contained in this Addendum are specific to the degree program at each institution as set forth below.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants contained in this Agreement, and of other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Degree Program(s).
  - a. College (“College Degree Programs”):  
**Associate of Applied Science in Human Services**  
**Associate of Arts**
  - b. University (“University Degree Program”):  
**Bachelor of Science in Social Work**
2. This Addendum will commence on date of last signature (“Effective Date”) and shall automatically expire on June 30, 2029, along with the Agreement, unless otherwise terminated as set forth in the Agreement.
  - a. Any transfer degree program/pathway(s) and/or or the Addendum in totality may be terminated by either institution upon notice to the other, as outlined in the Agreement.
3. The University Degree Program will be delivered in the following modality(ies): in-person course offerings.
4. Designated representatives from each institution will confer annually to review this Addendum as necessary, based on curriculum changes. Articulation courses may be added or removed from the articulation at that time.
  - a. Any revisions to the specific curriculum pathway(s) during the terms of this agreement must be approved in writing by the respective Parties and will be applied to new students undertaking the applicable program.
5. This Addendum defines pathway(s) by which a student could articulate the College Degree Program into the University Degree Program. Due to individual student factors, including but not limited to part-time or full-time status, need for developmental coursework, scheduling and availability of courses, all students may not be able to

complete the listed pathway in the time projected. This Addendum does not guarantee the completion of a baccalaureate in four years, or in two years beyond the associate degree level. All articulated pathways are included in this Addendum, at the time of signing, in Attachment A.
