The Transfer Pathway presumes that AU's MLG, CCI, CP1, CP2, REL, HR, SS, NSC, HUM, and half of AES will be taken at Columbus State. COM and the other half of AES will be met at AU.

Each sequence below is a single table. Shaded rows mark the start of each semester. Columbus State Community College courses that count toward the Ashland University Core are labeled "AU Core," and courses that count toward the Ashland University major are labeled "AU Major." Courses that count toward the AU Communication concentration are labeled "AU COM". Courses listed as "Choose one" refer to the category lists in the Course Options and Equivalencies section of this document.
